- Camera

- Dry cut diamond saw
- Air hose with M style fitting
- 10 x 10 foot canopy, preferably without a center pole
- Chair, stool, small folding table
- 25 foot outdoor extension cord
- Sturdy shoes or work boots
- Work gloves and/or anti-vibration gloves
- Hearing protection
- Hat with brim or visor
- Insect repellent
- Sunblock
